**Steers will be judged as market steer prospects destined to be finished for summer/fall shows. They will NOT be judged as market-ready steers.**

Steers may arrive at the fairgrounds beginning Friday morning, April 13, 2001. Steers will be measured for hip height and weighed FROM 5:00 TO 6:30 pm. This information will be used to put steers into classes.

Show is scheduled for 4:30 pm on Saturday, April 14.

Exhibitors must be Virginia residents who have their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday by September 30, 2001 and not have had their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday before January 1, 2001.

All steers must be born on or after October 1, 1999, and owned by and in the care of the exhibitor by April 13, 2001.

Steers will be shown dry. No artificial substances may be applied to the hair. No butt fans will be allowed.

Youth exhibitors are expected to be the primary care provider for their cattle. Assistance on show day may only be provided by the parents or other members of the immediate family, a bona fide 4-H volunteer leader, Extension Agent, FFA Instructor, or another youth exhibitor with cattle entered in the show

An entry fee of \$8.00 per steer must accompany your entry.

A maximum of 2 steers may be entered by each exhibitor.

**Entries must be postmarked by April 2, 2001.**
