- 1. Heifers may arrive during the day on Friday, April 13, and should be in place by 6:00 pm.
- 2. Shows are scheduled for Saturday, April 14, Commercial Heifers at 11:30 am and Other Registered Breeds at 10:30 am.
- 3. All Heifers must be born on or after June 1, 1999, and owned by the exhibitor.

- 4. Exhibitors must have their 9th birthday by September 30, 2001 and not have had their 19th birthday before January 1, 20001
- 5. Classes will be determined after all entries are received, and will be established by age of the heifer.
- 6. Heifers will be shown dry. No artificial substances may be applied to the hair. No butt fans will be allowed.
- 7. Other Registered Heifers are breeds other than Angus, Simmental, Hereford, and Shorthorn. Heifer must be owned, in care of, and registration transferred to the name of the exhibitor by January 1, 2001.
- 8. <u>Commercial Replacement Heifers</u> are less than 3/4 blood, unregistered, grade, or crossbreds.
- 9. Youth exhibitors are expected to be the primary care provider for their cattle.

 Assistance on show day may only be provided by the parents or other members of the immediate family, a bona fide 4-H volunteer leader, Extension Agent, FFA Instructor, or another youth exhibitor with cattle entered in the show
- 9. An entry fee of \$8.00 per heifer must accompany your entry.
