1. Late Junior Heifer Calves calved March 1, 2005 and after
2. Early Junior Heifer Calves calved between January 1 and February 28, 2005
3. **Junior Heifer Calf Champion** (1, 2) - Rosette
4. **Reserve Junior Heifer Calf Champion** - Rosette
5. Late Senior Heifer Calves calved between November 1 and December 31, 2004
6. Early Senior Heifer Calves calved between September 1 and October 31, 2004
7. **Senior Heifer Calf Champion** (5, 6) - Rosette
8. **Reserve Senior Heifer Calf Champion** - Rosette
9. Late Summer Yearling Heifers calved between July 1 and August 31, 2004

### **Class**

10. Early Summer Yearling Heifers calved between May 1 and July 30, 2004
11. **Intermediate Champion** (9, 10) – Rosette
12. **Reserve Intermediate Champion** – Rosette
13. Late Junior Yearling Heifers calved between March 1 and April 30, 2004
14. Early Junior Yearling Heifers calved between January 1 and February 29, 2004
15. **Junior Champion Female** (13, 14) – Rosette

**Any female that qualifies for female classes in the Association's standard classifications are not eligible to show in the cow/calf classes.**

23. Cow/Calf Class – cows three (3) years of age and younger, cows must be born January 1, 2002 thru August 31, 2003. Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and be born January 1, 2005 or after.
24. Cow/Calf Class – cows four (4) years of age and older, cows must be born December 31, 2001 or earlier. Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and be born January 1, 2005 or after.
25. **Grand Champion Cow/Calf Pair** (23, 24) – Banner
26. **Reserve Grand Champion Cow/Calf Pair** – Banner

**Grand and reserve grand champion cow/calf pairs do not show for grand champion female and are ineligible to compete in the get-of-sire, junior get-of-sire and breeder's six-head classes.**

27. Late Junior Bull Calves calved March 1, 2005 and after
28. Early Junior Bull Calves calved between January 1 and February 28, 2005
29. **Junior Bull Calf Champion** (27, 28) – Rosette
30. **Reserve Junior Bull Calf Champion** – Rosette
31. Late Senior Bull Calves calved between November 1 and December 31, 2004
32. Early Senior Bull Calves calved between September 1 and October 31, 2004
33. **Senior Bull Calf Champion** (31, 32) – Rosette

35. Late Summer Yearling Bulls calved between July 1 and August 31, 2004
36. Early Summer Yearling Bulls calved between May 1 and June 30, 2004
37. **Intermediate Champion Bull** (35, 36) – Rosette
38. **Reserve Intermediate Champion Bull** – Rosette
39. Late Junior Yearling Bulls calved between March 1 and April 30, 2004
40. Early Junior Yearling Bulls calved between January 1 and February 29, 2004
41. **Junior Champion Bull** (39, 40) – Rosette
42. **Reserve Junior Champion Bull** – Rosette
43. Senior Yearling Bulls calved between September 1 and December 31, 2003
44. Summer Senior Yearling Bulls calved between May 1 and August 31, 2003
45. Two-Year old Bulls calved between January 1 and April 30, 2003

- 46. **Senior Champion Bull** (43, 44, 45) – Rosette
  - 47. **Reserve Senior Champion Bull** – Rosette
  - 48. **Grand Champion Bull** – Banner
  - 49. **Reserve Grand Champion Bull** (Champions and Reserve Champions competing) – Banner
  - 50. Get-Of-Sire: Four animals by one sire shown in the above classes, both sexes represented.
  - 51. Junior Get-Of-Sire: Three animals by one sire, both sexes represented, show in classes 1, 2, 5, 6, 9, 10, and 27, 28, 31, 32, 35, 36, 39, 40.
  - 52. Breeders Six Head: The exhibitor of the breeders six head must be breeder and first owner, identified by the same member code for the animals exhibited. Cattle owned by other exhibitors may be included provided the exhibitor of the breeder's six head is the breeder and first owner of the included animal(s). Animals must be exhibited in individual classes. Cattle bred and owned by a junior member(s) may be included if the exhibitor of the breeders six head is an individual or married couple and is the parent or legal guardian of the junior member(s).
  - 53. Produce of Dam – Two animals, either sex, from one dam to be shown in individual classes to be eligible. May be owned by more than one exhibitor.
  - 54. **Premier Exhibitor**
  - 55. **Premier Breeder**
-
